

Christmas Money Slider

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Supplies:

Cardstock – 1 piece 19cm x 16cm, 1 piece 18cm x 14cm

DSP – 1 piece 17.6cm x 7.1cm, 1 piece 16.7cm x 6.6cm

Ribbon – 46cm

Sticky Strip, Adhesive, Rhinestone Brad, Horizontal Slot Punch, Stampin' Dimensionals, Stamps, cardstock & inks for decorating front.

Instructions:

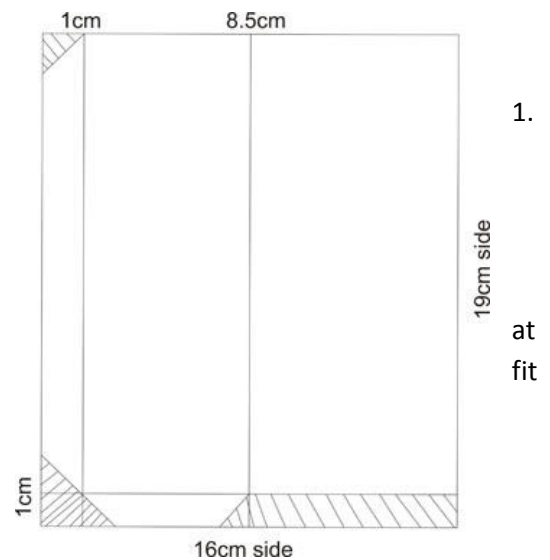
Main piece.

Score 19cm x 16cm piece as shown in diagram. Trim off shaded areas.

2. Fold along score lines and crease with Bone Folder.

3. Adhere DSP (17.6cm x 7.1cm piece) to front. Punch slot on front opening end approximately half way between score lines. Widen to ribbon nicely by punching again a little on each side of original slot.

4. Apply sticky strip to tabs and seal to form main piece making sure opening end lines up.



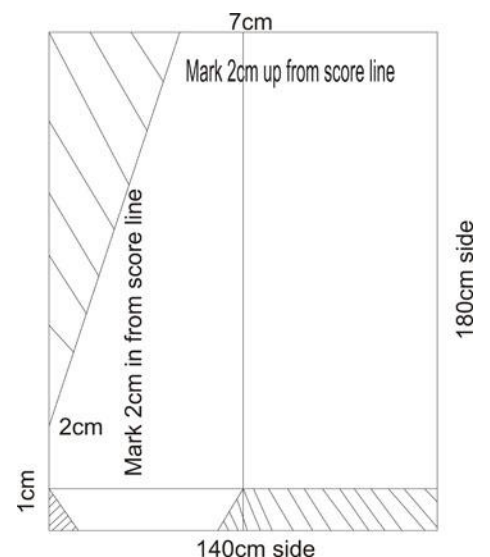
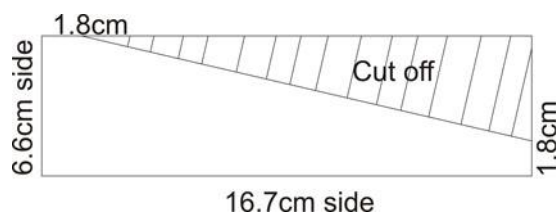
Slider

1. Score 18cm x 14 cm piece as shown in diagram.

2. Using a pencil, mark 2cm in from score lines as indicated. Draw line to join both markings and then cut off. Trim off other shaded areas.

3. Crease fold lines using a bone folder.

4. Mark 1.8cm in on sides as shown below, cut off shaded area.



5. Adhere dsp to front of slider.
6. Apply sticky strip to tab and inside front end (angled end). Remove liner and adhere to create slider.
7. Insert ribbon into slot from top (outside) and pull to outside so ribbon is in half. Insert slider in between ribbon and insert into card.
8. Use a brad to pinch ribbon together to from slider pull.
9. Decorate front as desired placing image over ribbon hole allowing for the ribbon to move freely.
